**August 26, 2015: Washington DC** - The Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (DNFSB) is pleased to announce that Mr. Bruce Hamilton of Dallas, Texas has been named as its newest member. He was confirmed by Congress on August 5, 2015, for a term expiring October 18, 2016.

Mr. Hamilton is a veteran of three and one-half decades working with nuclear energy. Prior to his appointment to the Board, he spent four years as President of the nuclear fuel procurement company Fuelco LLC, and preceding that he was an engineering director at Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant where he held a Nuclear Regulatory Commission Senior Reactor Operator's license. As a U.S. Navy officer, Hamilton supervised nuclear operations in six warships, commanded a seventh, and served as the Reactor Officer for the mid-life refueling overhaul of an aircraft carrier.



A registered professional engineer, Mr. Hamilton's academic credentials include a B.S. from Texas A&M University, an M.A. from the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School, and a Ph.D. from The Fletcher School of Law & Diplomacy.
