



DNFSB is pleased to present its results from the 2015 Federal Employee Viewpoint Survey (FEVS). DNFSB's FEVS results indicate the agency made notable progress in multiple areas in FY 2015. This progress was the result of continuing efforts to improve employee engagement, communication, employee recognition, and overall employee satisfaction. The DNFSB is committed to using the FEVS results to improve the way it accomplishes its mission to ensure the adequate protection of the public and the workers at DOE's defense nuclear facilities.

Highlights from DNFSB's 2015 FEVS results include:

- This year DNFSB achieved a response rate of 84% (34% higher than the government-wide average). DNFSB's leadership expresses its appreciation to agency employees for their participation in the survey and has pledged their commitment to using the feedback to build and expand on the successes of FY 2015.
- In comparison to the 2014 survey results, DNFSB experienced increases in almost all of their scores (96%), with 59% of the scores improving by double-digits. This is very encouraging and shows the agency is moving in the right direction. DNFSB employees continue to feel a strong connection to DNFSB's mission; agree there is Agency support for their professional development; and strongly endorse the agency's Supervisors.

DNFSB will continue its ongoing improvement efforts by providing employees with access to the FEVS results and by using the results, along with other feedback data, to develop Action Plans to influence positive change.
