If the material is proposed for redaction on the basis that the material is covered by a privilege other than the attorney-client privilege, a failure to approve the redaction shall be considered a waiver of that privilege.

The characterization of Board or Agency material as being authorized by the FOIA for redaction should be made with great sensitivity to the overarching goal of transparency of our government. Redaction should be used sparingly for detailed and specific activities. When in doubt about whether information is authorized for redaction, it is better to favor more transparency.

Arguably, there is not always bright line test for redaction; it is often grey. The revision being proposed would put the burden of a redaction decision on the Board, where it appropriately lies. Given that a quorum and a majority of the Board would be needed to redact, the balance in that grey area would be tilted towards greater transparency in government.
