Proposed Amendment: Amend page 9, Section "II. Nuclear Weapon Operations/Y-12 National Security Complex/Enriched Uranium Strategy" by deleting the 4th and 5th sentences from the first paragraph that reads – "In 2016, the Board's staff reviewed the conceptual design of the calciner. The staff team provided observations to NNSA regarding fire protection, nuclear criticality safety, confinement, and structural design strategies. The review identified no safety issues that would preclude advancing to the next design stage."

Justification: During the reporting period covered by this report to Congress, the Board has not formally communicated to DOE the Board's conclusions on these topics. Also, the term "safety issues" is not defined.
