As with similar staffing proposals, this should be taken up with the Board holistically through the staffing plan. I have observed a number of contracting actions that look to move OGC work to contracts, perhaps as a further justification to limit the number of OGC staff. The Staffing Plan is and has been the purview of the Board and should not be circumvented through actions that commit/redirect Board resources to address OGC workload as a justification for reducing staff numbers without Board discussion and vote.

This proposal came to us several times, once as an Amendment to a staffing plan, once as an adjustment to a staffing plan that was not approved, and now as a standalone RFBA. In the previous cases, this action was not approved. As a matter of principle, when an issue is proposed and voted on by the Board, it should not be re-proposed by the minority voter. This is tantamount to reconsidering a question, and Robert's Rules and other similar procedures dictate that only a voter with the prevailing view who has changed his or her mind should put forward a motion to reconsider. This is not explicitly in our procedures but I believe it is a good practice.
