In your letter of August 30, 2000, the Board forwarded a report on their review of the preparations for resumption of the enriched uranium reduction process at the Y-12 Plant and requested a briefing on the resolution of the reported concern/issues prior to the conduct of the Department of Energy Operational Readiness Review for the process. Enclosed is a memorandum dated September 29, 2000, which commits to the requested briefing after the contractor has declared readiness for restart of the process. The readiness declaration is not expected prior to December 2000. This commitment was previously discussed with the Board staff. Our staff will coordinate the briefing with Board Site Representatives when readiness for resumption is achieved.
