COMPLETION DATES OF THE DEFENSE NUCLEAR FACILITIES SAFETY BOARD (DNFSB) RECOMMENDATION 93-5 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (IP), REVISION 1, MILESTONES TO **RESOLVE THE HIGH-HEAT SAFETY ISSUE** 

My letter to you, "Late Delivery of the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (DNFSB) Recommendation 93-5 Implementation Plan (IP), Revision 1, Milestones to Resolve the High-Heat Safety Issue," 97-WDD-061, dated May 23, 1997, specified that the completion dates for DNFSB Recommendation 93-5 IP, Revision 1, Milestones 5.4.3.6.c, "Letter Reporting Initiation of Tank C-106 Waste Retrieval," and 5.4.3.6.d, "Letter Reporting Completion of Topical Report to Resolve the High-Heat Safety Issue," would be delayed. It also stated that the completion dates would be finalized after completion of the safety assessment.

The safety assessment was completed in September 1997. Completion dates for Milestones 5.4.3.6.c and 5.4.3.6.d have been determined to be November 1998, and December 1999, respectively.
