COMPLETION OF DEFENSE NUCLEAR FACILITIES SAFETY BOARD (DNFSB) RECOMMENDATION 93-5 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (IP), REVISION 1, MILESTONE 5.4.3.5.1, "LETTER REPORTING REFINEMENT OF FLAMMABLE GAS GENERATION/RETENTION MODELS USING VOIDMETER AND RETAINED GAS SAMPLING DATA"

This letter reports completion of "Gas Retention and Release Behavior in Hanford Double-Shell Waste Tanks," PNNL-11536, Revision 1, dated May 1997. This deliverable is identified under the DNFSB Recommendation 93-5 IP, Revision 1, Milestone 5.4.3.5.1.

The IP requires data from waste density, viscosity, void fraction, gas retention, and composition be used to refine the gas generation and retention models.

The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office has completed the actions identified under this milestone and proposes closure of this commitment.
