COMPLETION OF DEFENSE NUCLEAR FACILITIES SAFETY BOARD (DNFSB) RECOMMENDATION 93-5 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (IP), REVISION 1, MILESTONE 5.4.3.5.h, "LETTER REPORTING COMPLETION OF SUPPORTING TECHNICAL DOCUMENT ON FLAMMABLE GAS SAFETY ISSUE"

This letter reports completion of the "Flammable Gas Project Topical Report," HNF-SP-1193, Revision 2, dated January 1997, which is identified under the DNFSB Recommendation 93-5 IP, Revision 1, Milestone 5.4.3.5.h.

The IP requires this topical report to describe the current understanding of the Flammable Gas Safety Issue and future work for resolution of the issue.
