



I do not support filling a vacant Site Representative position by advertising the position in USA Jobs. Before relocating to a site, an individual hired in this manner should be required to work at the Board's headquarters for a two-year probationary period. During this probationary period, the employee should become familiar with the Board's approach to safety oversight and complete the Site Representative training. Also during this probationary period, the Deputy Technical Director shall evaluate the employee's performance and conduct. Before the end of the employee's two-year trial period, the Deputy Technical Director should recommend, with concurrence from the Technical Director and the Chairman, whether or not the employee should be assigned to a Site Representative position.


