Delete the last sentence, which currently reads:

“Finally, we encourage DOE to progress toward widespread application of Standard 3009-2014 in order to benefit fully from the strengthened nuclear safety requirements.”

Justification

The sentence is gratuitous. If there are specific facilities beyond the two referenced in the first paragraph that require strengthened nuclear safety requirements, we should identify those. Short of that, adequate protection has been assured by application of the prior standard and thus the benefit of the new standard is not apparent.




