SUBJECT: Pantex Plant Activity Report for Week Ending August 22, 1997.

1. DNFSB Activity Summary: Harry Waugh was on site all week. Tim Dwyer is on Military Leave until August 25.

2. New Issues:

a. <u>Secondary Storage in Building 12-66:</u> After a review of a Mason & Hanger Readiness Assessment and subsequent corrective actions, DOE/AAO approved this week the storage of secondaries in Building 12-66. They will be stored in approved off-site shipping containers. Copies of the Readiness Assessment, corrective actions, and approval letter have been forwarded to Board staff.

3. Follow-Up Issues:

- a. <u>MC3395 Removal Program:</u> The last MC3395 was removed from its associated shipping container last week, ahead of schedule. The last shipment of these items will occur before the end of the month.
- b. <u>Dynamic Balancer</u>: The Restart Team began incorporating the comments suggested last week by the management team. They are now hoping to be ready for an Area Office review on September 8 and restart on September 15.
- c. <u>Lightning Protection Bonding Status:</u> Lightning protection bonding and validation has now been completed on four 12-44 Cells, two 12-64 Bays, five 12-104 Bays, Cell 12-96, and Bay 12-84-2.
- d. <u>B61-5 Dismantlement:</u> Dismantlement of the last B61-5 was successfully completed this week.
- e. <u>AT-400A Pit Packaging:</u> Packaging of the first W48 pit in an AT-400A shipping container was scheduled to start on Thursday. However, because of a pit serial number identification problem, packaging did not start until today. They are still planning to complete the first package this week although it will require working on Saturday.
